

# **OHIO MINI REX RABBIT CLUB**

## **GUIDELINES FOR THE YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP**

1. The OMRRC Youth Scholarship shall be governed solely by the OMRRC Youth Scholarship Committee.
2. The committee shall consist of three members and a chairperson, as well, as the Secretary/Treasurer of the OMRRC.
3. The withdrawal of monies for award of the OMRRC Youth Scholarship(s) shall be made by the OMRRC Secretary/Treasurer upon written request from the OMRRC Youth Scholarship Committee Chairperson.
4. Monies withdrawn for the OMRRC Youth Scholarship award(s) shall be included in the report made by the OMRRC Secretary/Treasurer at the annual meeting. This report shall be published in the OMRRC Newsletter.
5. The amount awarded for each OMRRC Youth Scholarship shall be \$500.00. There will be a minimum of 1 scholarship awarded each year. Each scholarship awarded by the OMRRC Youth Scholarship Committee shall be approved by the OMRRC Board of Directors.
6. The recipient(s) of the OMRRC Youth Scholarship shall be selected prior to the OMRRC Columbus Specialty Show in May. The Scholarship(s) will be awarded at the annual meeting held in May at the Columbus OMRRC Specialty Show.
7. The OMRRC Youth Scholarship Committee shall be responsible for application forms, criteria, and selection of scholarship winners.

### **Requirements for Receiving a Scholarship**

1. The recipient must have been a member of the OMRRC for at least three (3) consecutive years with no lapse in membership prior to submitting an application.
2. The Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or in their first year of college.
3. The Applicant must be active in raising and showing rabbits. They must provide proof of this activity. Proof shall consist of show reports listing them as a valid exhibitor. The Applicant must attend a minimum of five (5) ARBA sanctioned shows each year.
4. The scholarship will be paid to the school in the recipients' name upon submitting proof of enrollment in an accredited two or four year college/university or vocational school.
5. Completed application forms must be submitted to the OMRRC Youth Scholarship Committee Chairperson no later than March 31<sup>st</sup> of the year that the scholarship is to be awarded.
